

# Flower Chandelier

Hang these whimsical paper blossoms above your dining table, buffet table or sideboard to create a playful focal point for any party or springtime gathering.

## What you'll need

- Petal template
- Scissors
- Construction paper, newspaper and/or scrapbooking paper
- Pen or pencil
- Double-sided tape
- Thin ribbon or string
- Heavy-duty tape

## How to make it

1. Print and cut out the petal template (scaling up or down, depending on how large you'd like your flower); then cut out four rectangles of paper that are slightly longer than the template.
2. Stack the paper rectangles and trace the template onto the top sheet. Hold the sheets together to cut out four petals all at once.
3. Crease the center of each petal lightly, and use a piece of the double-sided tape to hold each center closed.
4. Use the double-sided tape to adhere the centers of the four petals together.
5. Cut a piece of the ribbon slightly longer than you will need to hang your flower.
6. Tie the end of the ribbon around the center of your stack.
7. Fan out the petals and use a small piece of the double-sided tape to secure each petal to the one next to it in order to create a full flower.
8. Tie the flower to your ceiling light fixture, or use the heavy-duty tape to attach a cluster to the ceiling.
